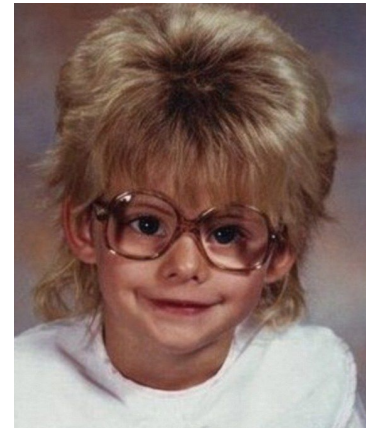
LIVESTREAM HOME ATHLETIC EVENTS

Search for Calvary Christian High School and submit payment to activate the account.
