WARRIOR SOFTBALL TEAM WINS STATE CHAMPIONSHIP

Even though the 2021-22 school year had dismissed for the year, the Warrior Softball Team continued their season by advancing to the FHSAA 3A State Championship. The semifinals were held on Wednesday, May 25th in Clermont. The Warriors faced Baldwin High School. It was a hard fought game and the score was tied 3-3 after regulation play of 7 innings. It only took 1 extra inning for the Warriors to score 2 runs and earn the victory, 5-3, to advance to the state championship game. The championship game was played the next day against Hernando High School, again in Clermont. The Warriors jumped out to a 3-0 lead in the 1st inning, but Hernando bounced back with 4 runs in the second. The Warriors scored a run in the 3rd inning to tie the game, and then in the 5th inning, the Warriors put 3 runs on the board to secure the win, 7-4, and earn the school's first state championship in softball.



CCHS is proud of the softball team and the way they represented the school throughout the season. On **Friday, August 19th**, the softball team will be recognized in the Friday assembly to be held at **10:00 AM in the Worship Center**. The team will present their state championship trophy to the school, and we will once again, celebrate this memorable championship for CCHS athletics.
