CCHS has designated the home football game on **Friday, August 26th** as Gold Together Night. September is Childhood Cancer Awareness Month, a time to honor and remember children and families affected by these rare diseases, and help rally support to give kids with cancer better outcomes by supporting research. For the past six years, CCHS has partnered with the #GoldTogether initiative—a program to support families facing a diagnosis and to raise funds to end childhood cancer. The initiative was started by Cole Eicher, a CCHS graduate in the Class of 2020.

Fans attending the game are asked to wear #GoldTogether T-shirts, or gold colored apparel to show support for childhood cancer research. The #GoldTogether initiative will be selling #GoldTogether T-shirts with the Calvary logo imprinted on the shirt. Students may wear the #GoldTogether T-shirts to school on Fridays. Plan now to attend the game, purchase a T-shirt, and/or make a donation to the #GoldTogether initiative. Kick-off is set for 7:00 PM vs. Victory Christian. Plan to arrive early and show your gold as the Warriors and the honorary captains (children and family members with a childhood cancer diagnosis) take the field.
