## PSAT/ NMSQT

ON WEDNESDAY,  
OCTOBER 12

Students in 9th, 10th and 11th grades will participate in the national testing date for the PSAT/NMSQT on **Wednesday, October 12th**. The PSAT is sponsored by the CollegeBoard and is a standardized test that provides firsthand practice for the SAT. Additionally, scores on the PSAT are used to determine course placement for honors and/or AP classes. The PSAT has 3 tests (Reading, Writing and Language, and Math).

Students in grades 9th, 10th and 11th need to arrive promptly on test day and will be dismissed at 11:45 a.m. After school supervision will not be available. Unless a student has a team or group practice after dismissal, he/she must make necessary preparations to leave campus by 12:15 p.m.

Seniors will not take the PSAT; therefore, **Seniors are not required to attend school on October 12th**. There is the option for Seniors to attend the College Application Assistance Workshop from 10am-Noon in Café One-22. Seniors are expected to attend team or group practices in the afternoon.

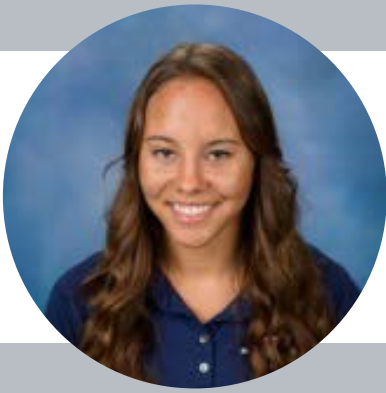
