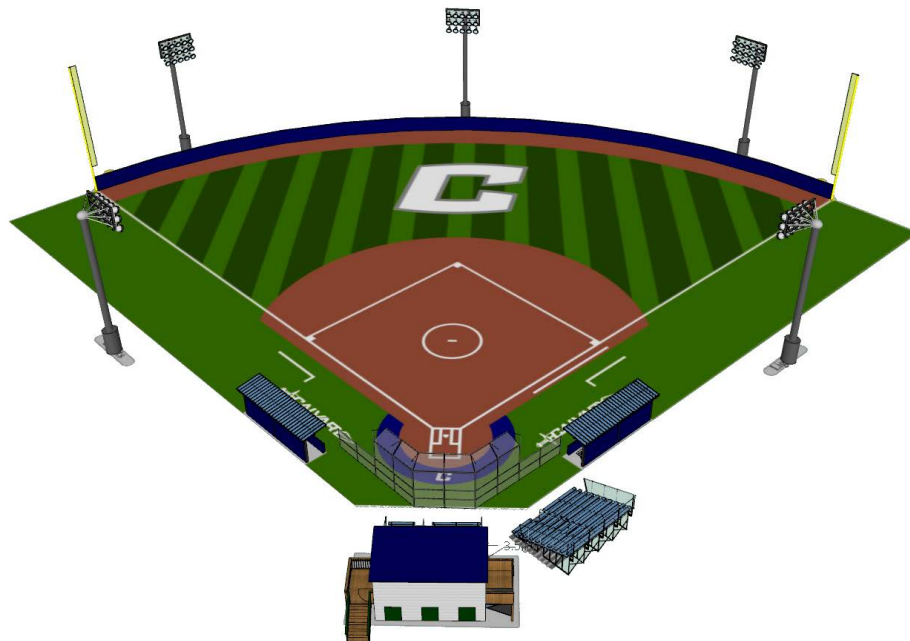

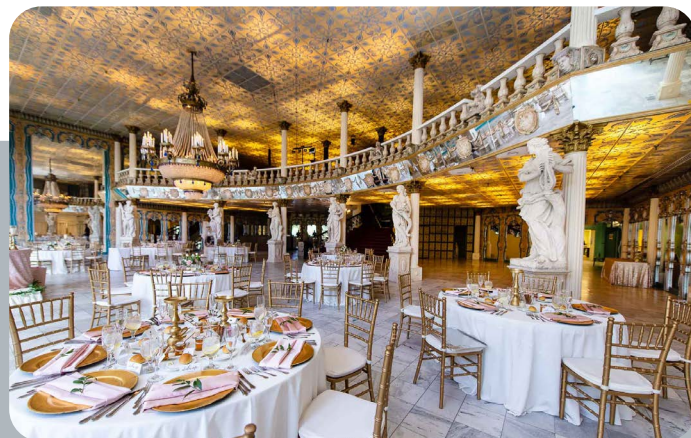
YOU ARE INVITED

During the event, SPC reps will cover enrollment next steps with you, walk students through the change of status form (see registration for required forms), and celebrate you and your enrollment to SPC!

Roberto's Kids

Is old baseball or softball equipment taking up space in your garage? If so, then step up to the plate and donate. In conjunction with the Roberto's Kids program, CCHS junior and Warrior baseball player, Carson Brady, has organized a second annual equipment collection effort that all Warrior families are invited to participate in.

Roberto's Kids is an international non-profit organization named after Major League Baseball player Roberto Clemente who was heavily involved in charity work but was tragically killed in an airplane crash in 1972. Roberto's Kids was established in 2006 as a way to collect and distribute new and used baseball and softball equipment to children in the Dominican Republic. Today, Roberto's Kids distributes 50 tons of equipment around the world each year.

New or used baseball and softball equipment to be collected includes:

Gloves

Bats

Baseballs or softballs

Bases

Catcher's gear

Batting helmets

Cleats

Uniforms, hats, socks

Members of the Warrior baseball teams will be collecting equipment at the admission gate of the JV Navy and Varsity baseball games being played at Victory Field against Cardinal Mooney at **4:30 PM** and **7:30 PM** on **Tuesday, March 21st**. As a thank you for donations, each donor will receive a ticket to be entered into a gift card raffle. One of the prizes is 4 tickets to a 2023 Rays game. For those not able to attend the games, collection bins will also be available for donations at both the west and south student drop-off and pick-up locations on **Tuesday, March 21st and Wednesday, March 22nd**. All donated equipment will be distributed to deserving youth in need.
