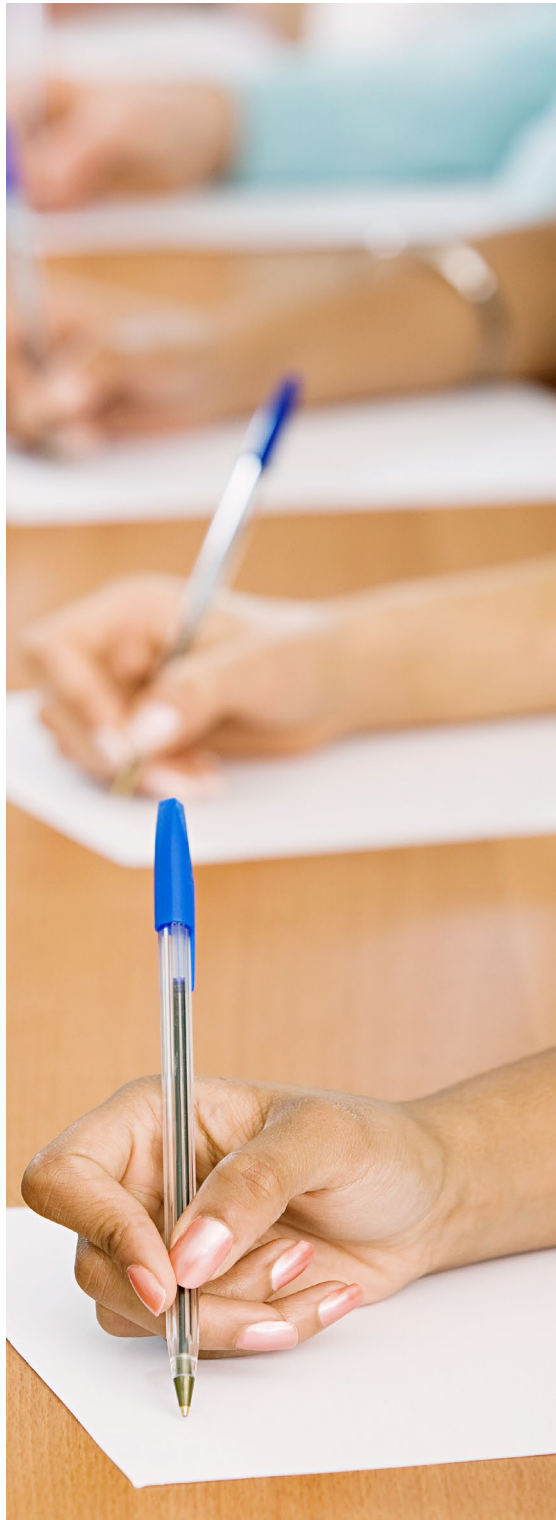
## CCHS STUDENTS EXCEL IN ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) TESTING

CCHS has a long history of excellent AP scores and 2023 is no exception! With 270 students taking 423 exams in 16 different subjects, 13 subjects had at least an 80% pass rate with 6 subjects at more than 90% passing. An

amazing 4 subjects had a 100% pass rate – 3D Art, Calculus BC, English Literature and Spanish Language! Overall, 88% of our AP courses/students far surpassed the global pass rate posted by CollegeBoard. In addition to our Athletic and Fine Art victories, CCHS Warriors are winners academically! Congratulations to all our AP students and teachers!
