

# GOLD TOGETHER EMPHASIS

CCHS has designated the games listed below as **Gold Together Nights**. September is Childhood Cancer Awareness Month, a time to honor and remember children and families affected by these rare diseases, and help rally support to give kids with cancer better outcomes by supporting research. For the past seven years, CCHS has partnered with the #GoldTogether initiative—a program to support families facing a diagnosis and to raise funds to end childhood cancer. The initiative was started by Cole Eicher, a CCHS graduate in the Class of 2020.

Fans attending the games are asked to wear #GoldTogether T-shirts, or gold colored apparel to show support for childhood cancer research. The #GoldTogether initiative will be selling #GoldTogether T-shirts with the Calvary logo imprinted on the shirts at the games. Students may wear the #GoldTogether T-shirts to school on Fridays.
