- **Love** – Places the needs of others before their own personal needs. Lives a life that demonstrates a real love for others.
- **Loyalty** – Consistently loyal to the programs, plans, and goals of the school and their friends.
- **Wisdom** – Makes wise decisions. Actions and words give evidence they examine and consider situations from a Biblical perspective.

BEAT CCC SHIRTS ON SALE FOR \$5



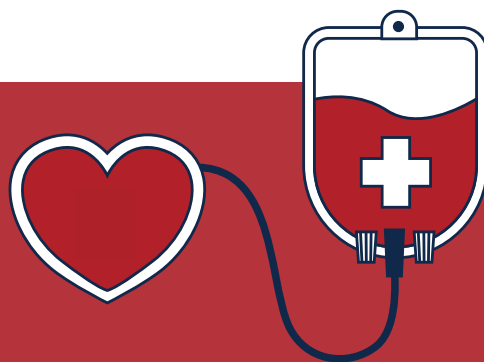
