#### 2023 THANKSGIVING/CHRISTMAS PROJECT CHALLENGE

Grant Park is an inner city school in East Tampa with an enrollment of 91 students in grades Pre-K 4-8th grade. The mission of the school is to connect children and families to Christ through Christian education. Their vision for children in the Grant Park community is to develop lifelong Christian character traits making the students strong enough to withstand life's challenges as they embark on their high school years and beyond. Recently, some of CCHS' Student Government officers visited Grant Park Christian Academy. The students saw a great need for children less fortunate and a school without many educational resources. The officers are ready to challenge their classmates to give to make a difference in this community and the lives of the students. The needs for the students include clothing, school supplies, and hygiene products. The school has dedicated employees who love their students, but the school operates with minimal resources for instructional support. This method of exam administration allows for a high rate of exam integrity as all students in a course will take their exam concurrently, regardless of when they take that class each school day. 

# THE BUCKSHOT O'BRIEN BASKETBALL CLASSIC




The tournament features a banquet for all of the teams and their coaches. The banquet will be held on Monday, November 20th, before the first game of the tournament tips off. The guest speaker at the banquet will be CCHS parent and former professional basketball player, Matt Geiger. Geiger's successful high school and college basketball career led him to be selected by the Miami Heat with the 42nd overall pick in the 1992 NBA draft. Geiger played for 10 years in the NBA and played in the Finals in 2001 as a member of the Philadelphia 76ers. In the Finals, Geiger played against Kobe Bryant and Shaquille O'Neil of the Los Angeles Lakers. His career in the NBA also included playing against Michael Jordan.
