The school has dedicated employees who love their students, but the school operates with minimal resources for instructional support. Grant Park has identified a need for a jungle gym set for the playground and school uniforms for some of the students. The Band competed on Saturday, November 11th, against 18 marching bands from across the state of Florida. The Warriors' 2023 Field Show was entitled, "Take Refuge." The show was based on the plot of Aesop's fable "The Ants and the Grasshopper" and communicated the importance of preparing for eternity, finding our refuge in God, and having compassion for others. The show's musical selections included "Elsa and Anna" from the movie Frozen, "The Frozen Cathedral" by John Mackey, "Glow" by Eric Whitacre, "Call of the Mountain" by Joseph Curiale, and "A Mighty Fortress is Our God" by Martin Luther. 10:15 – 12:15 | Social Studies Exams



Students will have the opportunity to request up to two exam exemptions. Exemptions will be requested on Monday, December 11th during each student's Bible class. Please make it a priority to be in your Bible class on this day. Remember, if you have 5 or fewer absences and a SEMESTER GRADE of A in a class, you will have the opportunity to exempt the Semester 1 Exam. If you find you have two exams scheduled at the same time, and if you are eligible to exempt one of the conflicting exams, please make this one of your two exam exemptions.
