Renewability Conditions are as follows:

- 2.75 cumulative **college** grade point average
- Continued enrollment at an approved Christian college/university
- Written response regarding the development of your Biblical Worldview
- An update on your walk with Jesus Christ
- Information concerning your participation in ministries and/or service opportunities
- An update on plans in your field of study/degree

Are you planning to earn the Bright Futures scholarship? Double check to make sure you've accomplished all of your student responsibilities:

- 1. Completed the FFAA- ACCESS THE FFAA HERE.
- 2. Have sent your most up-to-date SAT/ACT/CLT scores to a Florida PUBLIC university. (Even if you plan on attending a Florida PRIVATE university, you must send your scores to one of the 12 Florida Public universities, so they are entered into the Florida repository of scores)
 - a. Scores will be accepted until August 31, 2025.
- 3. Logged 75-100 hours of community service with CCHS.
- **4.** Committed to finishing your final semester with the best grades possible to obtain the GPA requirements for the scholarship.
