## Registering for ACT SAT & CLT

**All juniors** should begin testing <u>no later</u> than this spring semester and retesting timelines should aim to achieve your goal score by fall of senior year. It is a CCHS graduation requirement to have at least one ACT, SAT, or CLT test score on file by the first day of senior year.

Sophomores on an advanced math track (completed Alg. I, Geom., and in Alg. II or completed Alg. I, Alg. II, and are in Geom.) should also consider testing in spring of sophomore year. Use the links above to make an appointment with your college counselor to discuss your testing plan.

### US Service Academies' Summer Programs for Current Juniors

Students considering application to the US Service Academies should give serious thought to applying to attend their summer seminar programs for juniors entering their senior year. These programs allow you to experience the life of a cadet, on-campus and attendance will improve your chances in the Academy application process.

- <u>US Air Force Academy Summer Seminar:</u> Summer Seminar allows participants to live like a US Air Force Academy cadet for four days. Applications open now through January 15, 2025.
- <u>US Military Academy (Army/West Point) The Summer Leaders Experience (SLE)</u>: Applications for SLE Summer 2025 will open on February 15th 2025
- <u>US Naval Academy Summer Seminar:</u> Your Summer Seminar application will also serve as a preliminary application to the Academy that you will complete before or during your senior year. Application opens January 6, 2025.
- US Coast Guard Academy AIM Summer Program: Application is open February 1, 2025.
