CCHS STUDENTS EXCEL IN ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) TESTING

CCHS has a long history of excellent AP scores and 2024 continued the tradition! With 309 students taking 532 exams in 19 different subjects, 10 subjects had at least an 80% pass rate with 5 subjects at more than 90% passing. Additionally, 4 subjects had a 100% pass rate: U.S. History, Drawing, Spanish Language and Computer Science Principles. 15 subjects exceeded the National Pass Rate published by the Collegeboard. From CCHS, 83 students have received an AP Scholar recognition. Congratulations to our AP students and teachers!
