#### **COLLEGE VISIT DAYS-- ATTENDANCE CLARIFICATION**

During last Friday's assembly, the updated CCHS attendance policy for absences was covered; full details of our attendance policy can be found on pages 28-33 of the Parent-Student Handbook, with details on approved college and career visit days specifically highlighted on pages 30-31.

Please note that students are still permitted to complete college visits as approved, excused "College Days" for attendance purposes.

Seniors are permitted **four** "college days" per school year. <u>In order for your attendance to be</u> <u>updated</u>, you must provide the proper documentation from the college within five school days of <u>your college visit</u>. The acceptable documentation needed is explained on pages 30-31 of the Parent-Student Handbook.
