

#### STAFF ACHIEVEMENT

CCHS COACH KIM (ZSCHAU) WHITNEY WILL BE INDUCTED INTO KANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY'S HALL OF FAME ON AUGUST 30TH, 2024

To be eligible for Hall of Fame nominations, a player must make significant contributions to the university's athletic achievements and prestige, and continue to uphold the values learned through Intercollegiate Athletics — all of which Coach Kim Whitney, CCHS Athletic Director and Head Volleyball Coach, has accomplished.

Whitney played Volleyball as a 4-year starter at K-State from 1995-1998, breaking records as one of their best volleyball players. She is one of four players in school history with over 1000 kills and digs. She ranks third in career games played at K-State with 457. She is one of only two players with three seasons of over 300 kills and digs. Whitney ranks second in career 20/20 double-doubles with four and holds the record

for the most double-doubles in school history with 69. She ranks second in career attacks with 4,632, second in career kills with 1,646, and third in career digs with 1,578, the most by an outside hitter. Whitney earned first-team All-Big 12 Conference honors when she was named a unanimous selection as a senior. This followed her selection to the honorable mention team as a junior. She was named the Big 12 Player of the Week on November 4, 1996, while she was a two-time Academic All-Big 12 honoree as a sophomore and iunior in 1996 and 1997.






Coach Whitney is excited and honored to join the Hall of Fame at K-State becoming the fourth volleyball player to be inducted at the university. Originally from Dunedin, FL, she took a leap of faith by attending K-State in Manhattan, Kansas. When choosing a college to play for, a Christian community was most important to her. Despite the 1,400-mile distance from home, she felt led by the Lord to attend

K-State and gives glory to God for the support and care she received by prioritizing her faith. "God reminds me that when I put Him first, He'll take care of me — and He has," she said.

graduating 1999, she continued to play indoor volleyball at a professional level for four years in the U.S. and internationally, and then played professional sand volleyball for 14 years. In 2001, she was invited to join the National playing alongside Team. Olympic athletes. She now uses her extreme talent and skill as Head Volleyball Coach in her 7th season at CCHS, with 14 years of prior coaching experience at the collegiate level.

Whitney feels blessed by her successes and believes that her experiences have shaped her into the coach she is today. She encourages her players to relate the highs and lows of the game to life experiences. "It's not

the highs and lows that are important, but the journey to get there" stated Whitney. Whitney has led the Warriors to great success, including a state championship in 2021. CCHS Head of School, Mr. David Kilgore said, "We are extremely thankful and proud of Coach Whitney. We are blessed by her incredible leadership and the positive impact she continues to have at CCHS."

## DESMOS CALCULATOR TRAINING FOR 11TH & 12TH GRADE STUDENTS TAKING THE DIGITAL SAT

The new digital SAT in the Spring of 2024 will allow students the use of a calculator on the entire math section. The CCHS Mathematics Dept, College Counseling, and Mrs. Kraus have partnered together to provide free training for highly motivated students who will be taking the digital SAT this fall to help them navigate the new tool.
