CCHS was scheduled to be closed on Monday, October 14th for Open House. Due to the cancellation of Open House, school will be in session on **Monday, October 14th**.

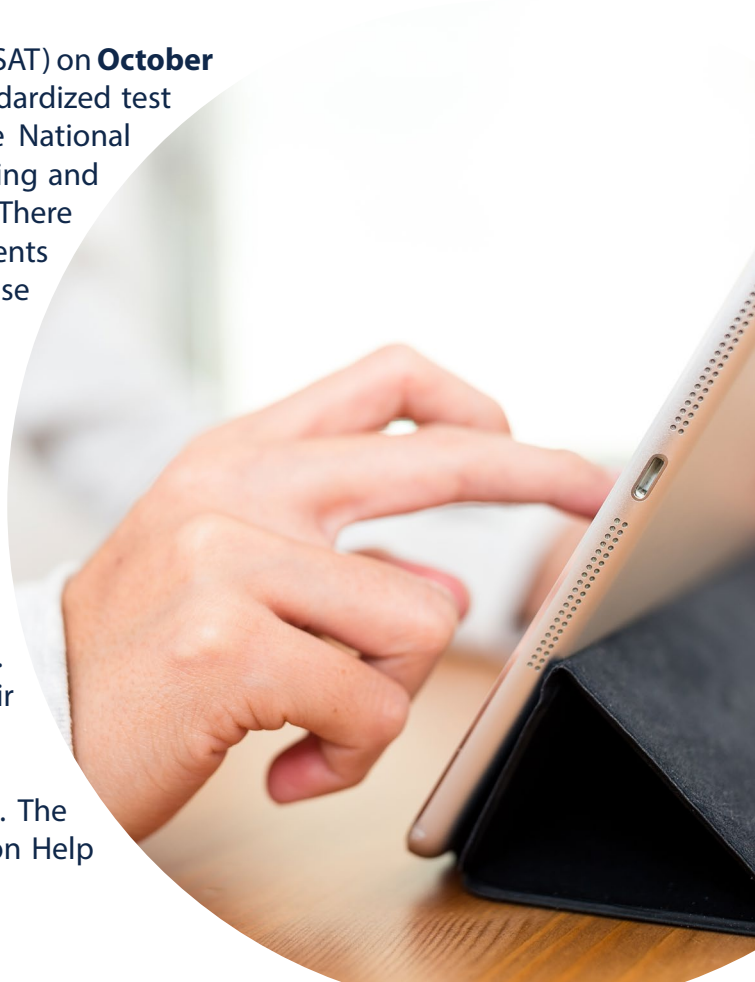
## PSAT TESTING DAY

Grades 9-11 will take the Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test (PSAT) on **October 23rd** from **7:45 AM to 11:15 AM**. The PSAT is an online standardized test administered by the College Board and cosponsored by the National Merit Scholarship Corporation that tests skills in reading, writing and math. This test is required for all CCHS students in grades 9-11. There isn't a make-up day for the PSAT; therefore, it is imperative students are present for the assessment. **Spirit Week is an exciting time at CCHS full of dress-up days, games, activities and competition to show and encourage school spirit.** *Students participating in Spirit Week theme days may wear casual (non-uniform) clothes each day of the week. The clothes must coordinate with the designated themes, be appropriate for school and conform to the dress code philosophy regarding modesty, identity, and propriety. Students may not dress as the opposite gender, wear clothes with holes or wear leggings. Students choosing not to dress up must wear school uniforms. CCHS will operate on an Activities Bell Schedule during Spirit Week. Listed below are the themes and activities for each day of Spirit Week:*
