REMINDER TO ALL DUAL CREDIT STUDENTS

The end of the semester is approaching and we want to remind all students enrolled in a Dual Credit course through SPC or BUF to monitor their progress and ensure you are maintaining a strong grade as these courses are the start to your college transcript. Poor performance in dual credit courses could be detrimental to your college admission. Be diligent in your studies and finish well!

Have you Applied? Have you been Accepted to College?

If you have applied <u>or</u> received a decision from a college on your application, please share it with your college counselor. <u>You can do this by updating your Naviance account.</u> This is confidential between you and your counselor. Updating your application status and acceptances will also notify the college counseling that you are meeting the following graduation requirements:

- 1. Submit one application to at least one 4-year college/university by December 19th
- 2. Admitted to at least one 4-year college/university by May 1st

How are ACT/SAT/CLT scores sent to Bright Futures?

A common question: "How do my ACT/SAT/CLT scores make it to Bright Futures?"

In order for the Bright Futures scholarship to receive your qualifying SAT/ACT/CLT test scores, the qualifying scores must be in the Florida repository of test scores. This is an online database of



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ACT/SAT/CLT scores that have been sent to Florida public universities. Bright Futures will retrieve your scores from this repository. In order for your scores to be entered into the repository, you must send your qualifying ACT/SAT/CLT scores to a Florida Public University by August 31, 2025. Even if you are not attending a Florida public university, you still must send your qualifying scores to a Florida public university (or community college such as SPC) in order for the scores to be retrieved by Bright Futures from the repository. You can pick any one of the twelve Florida public universities. It is the student's responsibility to send the qualifying scores by the required deadline of August 31, 2025. Official score reports can be requested through your ACT, CLT, or College Board portal. You can watch one of the tutorials below for directions on how to send your scores. You have until June of 2025 to earn a qualifying test score for Bright Futures. How to send SAT scores, How to send ACT scores OR How to send CLT scores

The application for the Bright Futures Scholarship (FFAA) is now open. Don't forget to complete this application if you wish to earn this scholarship to apply toward tuition at the Florida public universities, community colleges, state colleges, or accredited private universities/colleges.
