### FAFSA Opening by Dec 1 | Create Your FSA ID Now!

In order to prepare for the FAFSA opening in December, you should consider creating your FSA-ID now. The FSA ID is a username and password combination you use to log in to U.S. Department of Education (ED) online systems. You'll use your FSA ID every year you fill out a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®) form and for the lifetime of your federal student loans. NOTE: The FAFSA made changes last year. If you have completed it in the past, the application is now slightly different. It is in your best interest to educate yourself on the FAFSA changes and get ahead as much as possible, as money is awarded on a first-come, first-served basis. CREATE YOUR FSA-ID HERE

#### Mid Year Transcripts

Some colleges and universities <u>may</u> request a mid-year transcript for your application. Mid-year transcripts will be available in January after report cards are posted. You may request a mid-year transcript be sent to the college or university by requesting through Naviance. ### Have you Applied? Have you been Accepted to College?

If you have applied <u>or</u> received a decision from a college on your application, please share it with your college counselor. <u>You can do this by updating your Naviance account.</u> This is confidential between you and your counselor. Updating your application status and acceptances will also notify the college counseling that you are meeting the following graduation requirements:

- 1. Submit one application to at least one 4-year college/university by December 19th
- 2. Admitted to at least one 4-year college/university by May 1st
