WARRIOR MARCHING BAND - STATE CHAMPIONS

On Saturday, November 16th, the Warrior Marching Band competed at the Florida Marching Band Championships (FMBC) in the West Palm Beach area. After a successful State Semifinals performance in the morning, the band earned a top 5 score in Class 1A and advanced to the State Finals in the afternoon. Based on their performance in the State Finals, the Warrior Marching Band earned the FMBC Class 1A State Championship! This is the Warrior Marching Band's fifth state championship in the past six competitive seasons and the Warrior Marching Band now holds the record for the most Class 1A State Championships in FMBC history. In addition to winning the Class 1A State Championship, the Warrior Marching Band also earned the highest scores in the areas of Music and General Effect and their finals score of 86.1 was the second highest score in school history. The Warrior Marching Band's 2024 show, "The Tracks We Leave Behind," was based on the life story of hymn writer, Philip Bliss, who chose to use his music to further God's kingdom rather than to amass fame and wealth for himself. Philip Bliss is most famous for writing the music to the well-known hymn, "It is Well With My Soul." Congratulations to the **Warrior Marching Band!**








CCHS TO HOST THE BUCKSHOT O'BRIEN BASKETBALL TOURANMENT

His Hall of Fame career at Butler University and his professional basketball accomplishments were only the foundation of a life spent serving others. He was always giving back. He believed strongly in the mission of Calvary Christian High School and the development of our athletic programs. We are pleased to host this tournament in his memory. The Buckshot O'Brien Basketball tournament features a lunch banquet for all of the teams and their coaches. This year, the guest speaker is Charlie Ward, Jr. He is a devoted husband, father, mentor and coach who exemplifies the principles of integrity, hard work and unwavering faith in God. He has a significant impact on both sports and his community.

As a two-sport athlete at Florida State University (FSU), he achieved extraordinary success as a quarterback and point guard, earning over 30 awards in his senior year, including the Heisman Trophy, while leading the FSU Seminoles to their first football National Championship. After graduating with a Bachelor of Arts degree, Charlie was drafted by the National Basketball Association as a first-round pick for the New York Knicks, where he consistently helped the team reach the playoffs from 1996 to 2001. He played eleven seasons as a leading point guard in the NBA and served as an assistant coach with the Houston Rockets for two years. He now uses his experience as a full-time high school basketball coach at Florida State University High School. He received the All-Big Bend Coach of the Year award in 2021 and 2022 after winning the Florida High School Athletic Association Class 3A Championship. He was inducted into the Georgia High School Football Hall of Fame in 2022 and is featured in the biography, "The Athlete: Greatness, Grace and the Unprecedented Life of Charlie Ward," along with an ESPN documentary.

Married for over 25 years to Tonja, the couple has three children and has actively engaged in youth development through sports camps, music events, and charitable initiatives. These efforts led to the establishment of The Charlie and Tonja Ward Family Foundation to support youth character development and disaster relief efforts, embodying their commitment to giving back and uplifting others through their faith-driven mission. CCHS is honored to host Charlie Ward during the 2024 Buckshot O'Brien Basketball Classic.

CCHS has challenged all students to donate new, unwrapped toys to the *Merry Market.* In addition to collecting toys, a group of CCHS students have volunteered to help run the Merry Market on Saturday, December 14th. While all toys are appreciated, Lotz of Blessings has expressed a need of toys for ages 12 and older such as bikes, sports items and Lego sets. This is a great opportunity for students to also collaborate with their clubs, discipleship groups and Bible studies to purchase higher-priced items if desired. Bins will be located at both student drop-off entrances at CCHS to collect donations. A Toy Drive will also be hosted during CCHS Basketball games on December 6th. Spectators who bring a toy donation will receive free admission to the basketball game. CALVARY CHOIR SELECTED TO PERFORM AT DISNEY'S CANDLELIGHT PROCESSIONAL


