NEW SOFTBALL FIELD TO OPEN FOR THE SPRING SEASON OF 2025



On March 26th, 2023, families and friends of CCHS gathered at Victory Field (the baseball field) to hear Pastor Willy Rice and Mr. Kilgore share a vision for a softball field on campus. As the project was introduced and attendees walked the site location and prayed to make the vision a reality, an appeal for donations was made. Additional appeals for donations were made in the months ahead, and by the spring of 2024, CCHS had received enough donations and pledges for the project to move forward with construction. The softball field is located in an

area next to the Anderson Athletic Center and Victory Field. There has been significant progress that can be seen when driving down Bayview Avenue to Gulf-to-Bay Boulevard that has been made since construction began this past summer. CCHS is excited to announce that construction is on schedule to be completed in time for softball tryouts on January 21, 2025. CCHS is thankful for God's blessings to permit the field to be constructed. It is an outstanding facility and will provide CCHS students an opportunity to compete on a first-class field for many years to come.

While the project will be completed in January, the funds to fully pay for the facility have not been received. CCHS humbly asks those who are considering an end-of-year donation, to consider

SCHEDULE CHANGES

SCHEDULE CHANGES FOR THE SPRING SEMESTER WILL END AT 3:00 PM ON FRIDAY, JANUARY 10, 2025.

Students may review their schedules for the Spring Semester. To do this, login to a FACTS/Renweb account, select Student, select Schedule and view Quarter 3. All Spring Semester schedules should be correct, but if a schedule change is necessary, ***please consider the following:***

- While it is possible to move from an advanced level course to a traditional level course, it is not possible to move from a traditional level course to an advanced level course. To determine if a move to a traditional level will work, please consult the Class Availability Chart on the school website.
- Most classes are filled to optimal capacity, so requests are not guaranteed. Any open seats will be prioritized for students who need to meet a graduation requirement.
- Schedule change requests will not be made for preference (i.e., Student would like to move math to the morning because they will be leaving early for a sport).

To submit a request to make a schedule change, follow the steps below:

1. Refer to the **Class Availability Chart** to check for availability.
2. Complete the new **Schedule Change Request Form**. (A change to a 5th period class may change lunch assignments.)
3. **Only requests submitted on the form will be considered.** Sending an email to schedulechange@cchs.us without completing the Schedule Change Request Form will not count as requesting a schedule change. Click **here** for more information.
