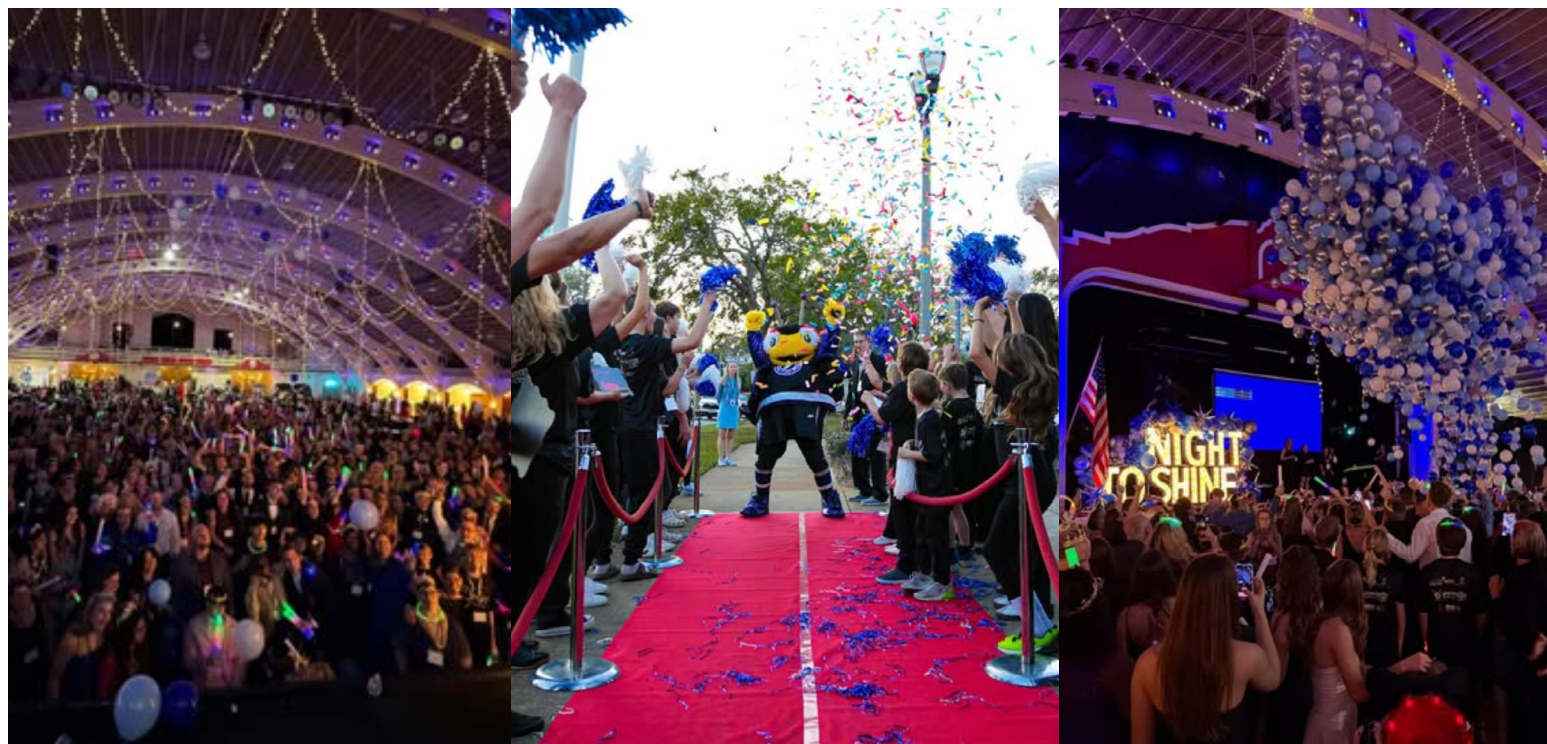


CALVARY'S GOT TALENT

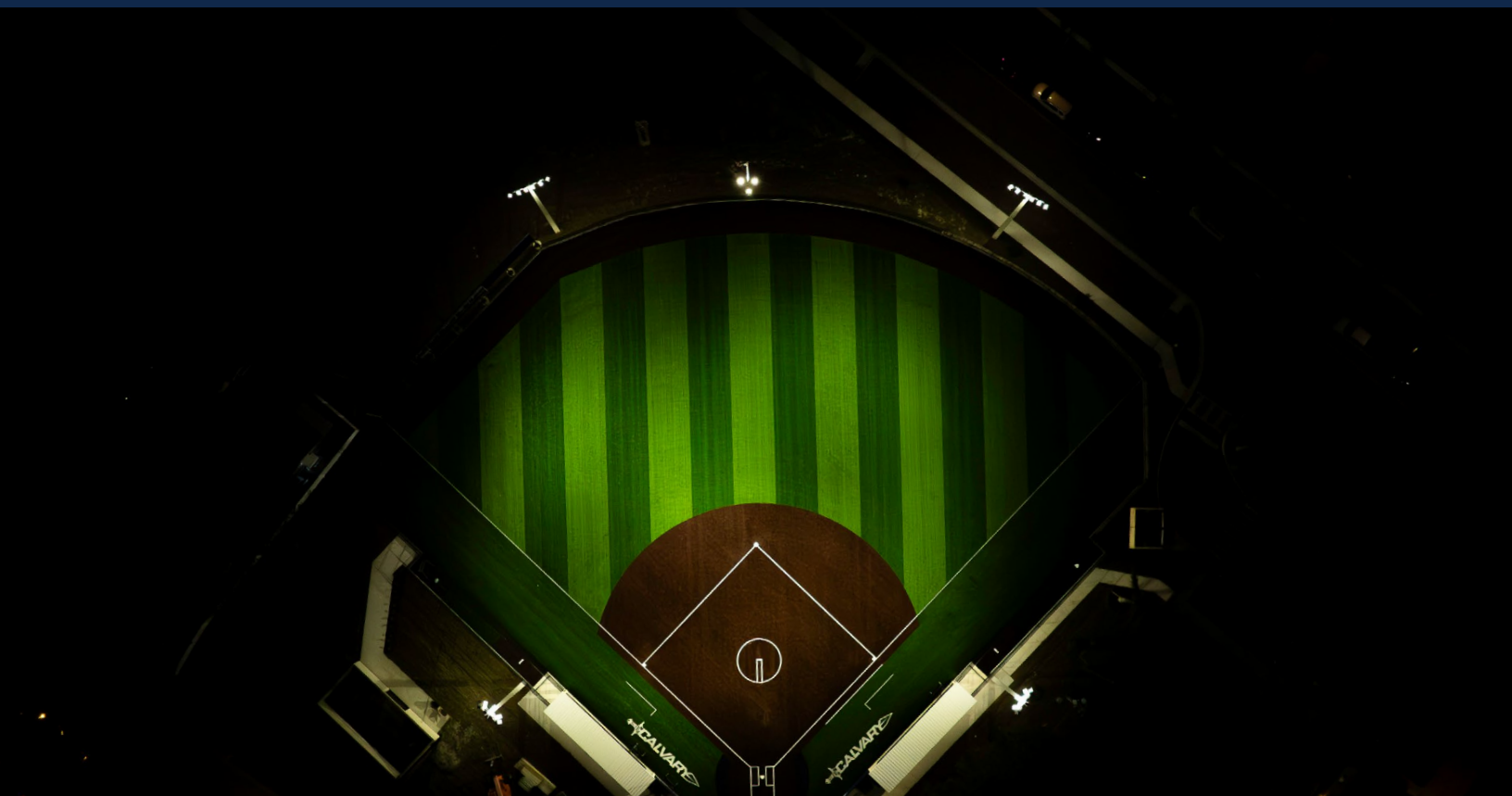
VARSITY BOYS SOCCER TEAM VOLUNTEERS AT NIGHT TO SHINE
