STANDARDIZED TESTING AT CCHS ON THURSDAY, MARCH 27TH

CCHS will be administering standardized testing on **March 27th**.

View instructions for each grade level below:

Grades 9 and 10:

- Students will take the Pre-ACT test to receive an estimated ACT score.
- Report to the assigned testing room at the beginning of the school day on Thursday, March 27th.
- CCHS will provide breakfast items for students.
- Bring pencils, a calculator, water, a snack, and a book for reading (optional).
- Testing will conclude around 11:15 AM.
- No after school supervision is available, so unless students have a team or group practice, they must leave campus by 11:45 AM.

Grade 11:

- Students will take the SAT during the school day.
- Report to the assigned testing room at the beginning of the school day on Thursday, March 27th .
- CCHS will provide breakfast items for students.
- Students will need a fully charged iPad, a pencil, calculator, water, snack, and a book (optional).
- Testing should conclude around 11:15 AM.
- No after school supervision is available, so unless students have a team or group practice, they must leave campus by 11:45 AM.

Grade 12:

- No school on Thursday, March 27th .
- Students are expected to attend team or group practices in the afternoon.
