

Friday, May 2nd: 6:30 PM


#### Saturday, May 3rd: 10:00 AM

#### **SPRING 2025 EXAM WEEK INFORMATION**

As the end of the school year approaches, please review the key details below to help prepare for spring exams.



#### All exam days will be half days, with dismissal at 12:15 PM.

No after school supervision is provided on the half days of exams.

#### What to Know:

- Exams are given in core subjects only (English, Math, Science, History, World Language).
- AP students are exempt from semester exams; their national AP exam fulfils the requirement.
- Students without exams may stay home or must report to our supervised study hall if on campus in Cafe A.
- Students must be in dress code, arrive on time, and stay for the full exam period.

#### Exam Exemption Criteria:

- 9th–11th Grade: May exempt up to 2 exams with an A average and 5 or fewer absences (Jan 13–May 12).
- 12th Grade: May exempt up to 4 exams with a B average and 5 or fewer absences.
- Dual Credit and AP classes are not eligible. Students with ISS/OSS must take all exams.

#### Exemption Request Process on May 12th:

- Students will receive the form via email at 7:45 AM and must submit it by 4:30 PM.
- Only students may complete the form using their CCHS email.
- Review eligibility via RenWeb Report Card starting May 12.
- Final exemption status will be approved and available in the report card on May 16.
