## Lunch Procedure Changes to Begin on Monday

New procedures for students picking up lunch will begin on Monday, August 26th. **First**, when Lunch A begins, the athletic hallway may only be used by students who are assigned to Lunch A. **Second**, all pre-ordered lunches are to be picked up in the athletic hallway as you enter the kitchen line area. There will be an additional table for the distribution of lunch orders. Students should make sure they are in the correct line to receive their order by choosing the line according to the first letter in their last name. **Third**, after receiving their pre-ordered lunch, students may choose to eat lunch in Café A, Café B, or Café One:22. The ala carte items will be available for pick-up or purchase in the kitchen line area and Café One:22. **Fourth**, the room (Café A, Café B, or Café One:22) a student chooses to eat lunch is where he/she must stay until the bell rings ending the lunch period.

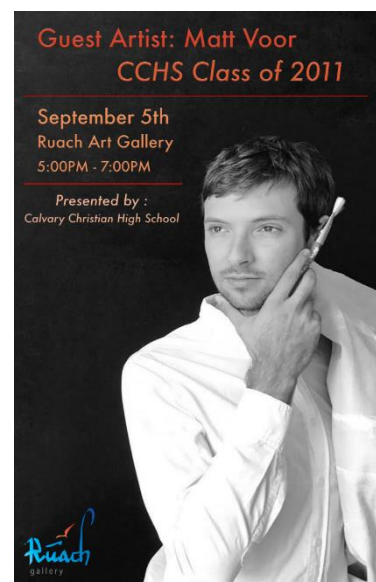

livestreamed. To view the stream requires the viewer to have an account with the NFHS Network. The service **may be purchased** on a month-by-month (\$9.99) basis, or for an entire year (12 mo.= \$69.99). To create an account, visit [www.calvarylive.us](http://www.calvarylive.us). Search for Calvary Christian High School and submit payment to activate the account. With an account, you may also view away games if the host school also streams their games through the NFHS Network. We are aware that some schools we play uses this service, but when you log-in to your account, you will see all upcoming games where the CCHS teams will be streamed, home or away.
