Semester Exam Exemption Requests Due on **FRIDAY**

CCHS students may qualify to exempt up to two exams per semester if their cumulative average in the class for the semester is a grade of "A" on Monday, December 9th at 7:30 AM. Additionally, students must have 5 or fewer absences in the class for the given semester. Students may not exempt the same subject exam both semesters during their 9th, 10th, and 11th grade years. Advanced Placement and Dual Credit classes are not eligible for exam exemption. Students requesting to exempt an exam must submit the requested Google form by Friday, November 22nd, 4:00 PM.
