## Blood Drive to be Held on Campus on WEDNESDAY

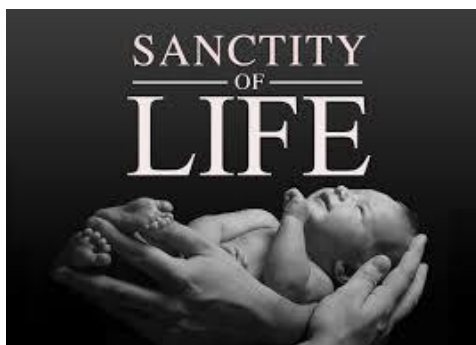
