Lady Warrior Track Team Wins Berkeley Invitational Athletes Break School Records

The Lady Warrior Track Team earned their second 1st place finish on the year on Saturday, February 29th Berkeley Prep Invitational. The team finished in 1st place out of 21 teams (12 were public schools and 9 were private schools) by scoring 97.5 points. The leading point scorers for the meet were the following athletes:

At the meet, Sophie Haag (Freshman) and Meredith Adams (Junior) broke the CCHS school records for their events. Sophie ran the 100-meter dash in 12.15 seconds to be atop the record board. Meredith threw the Discus 142-01 and the Javelin 101-02 to set the standard at CCHS for these events.

On Thursday, March 5th, the teams competed at another meet at Berkeley, but this meet was smaller with 10 teams competing. More school records were broken as Meredith set a new mark for the Javelin throw with a distance of 113-03, and Carson Pecore (Freshman) set the mark for the guys with a distance of 115-02.
