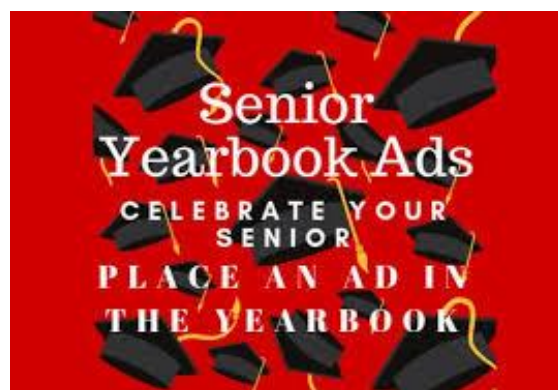


## Class of 2021 Dedication Ads for the CCHS Yearbook
