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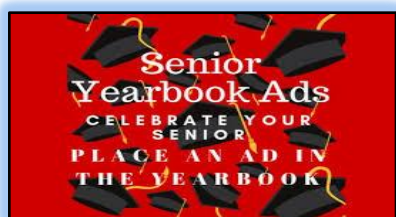
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Class of 2021 Dedication Ads for the CCHS Yearbook Deadlines Added

A fee of \$75 will apply to senior ad requests submitted between October 11-31st. After November 1, the late fee is \$100. No senior ad requests will be accepted after Monday, November 15th.** In reserving and creating the ad, you will work directly with Herff Jones, the publisher of the CCHS yearbook. 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Kate Thorington Receives National Spanish Exam Scholarship



Congratulations to Kate Thorington, a 2020 graduate of Calvary Christian High School, who received a second-place scholarship of \$1,000 from the National Spanish Examinations. Students become eligible for the scholarship by scoring in either the gold, silver, or bronze categories on the National Spanish Examinations. Students must then apply and submit a sample of their Spanish language writing and speaking. Their written and oral proficiencies are evaluated by a committee.

“Earning a scholarship for any student on the National Spanish Examinations is very prestigious,” said Kevin Cessna-Buscemi, National Director of the Exams, “because only 60 students are chosen from among the 140,000 students who take the National Spanish Exams each year.”

Students from Calvary Christian High School have a long history of high achievement on these exams and were taught by Spanish teachers Mrs. Lauren Davis and Mrs. Lisa Clarke. The National Spanish Examinations are administered each year and are sponsored by the American Association of Teachers of Spanish and Portuguese.

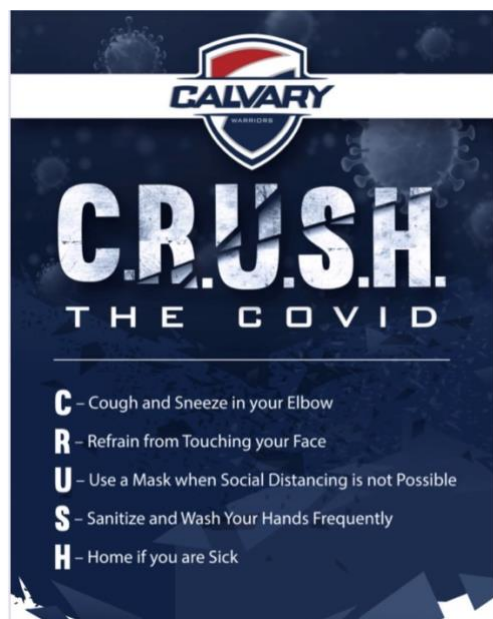
