You are inquiring about where you can serve for Community Service Hours. Great Question! The list below is just a small list of places to serve.

A few ideas: Check places closest to your home to make it easy for transportation. Find opportunities in areas that you enjoy or some area that you want to learn more about or help out to be successful!

- Look up Service Projects by location at VolunteerMatch.org
- **Serving Educators:** Some students enjoy going back to their middle school to help their former teachers at the end of the year to clean out rooms, organize PE equipment, and also help prep for the next year. You may want to help out during the year at different events, too.
- Athletics: If you play a sport at CCHS, you could consider being a summer camp counselor in that sport or another sport. The schedule will come out in late April, early May. Check the school website for more info.
