Female Dress Code for Prom

Appropriate and Modest



LENGTH

All dresses must be long / floor length

 Any slit in the dress (front or back) can be no higher than the knee

Must remain in compliance even after walking several steps

TOP

- Must have modest neckline
- No cleavage exposed
- If strapless, the top must meet above criteria AND stay in place while dancing
- Every "body" is different...what works for one, might not work for you!

FIT

- May not be "skin tight", or cling to bottom
- Choose materials & size wisely
- No bare midriff, or midriff exposed
- Back no lower than the small of your back

DRESSES NOT APPROVED:





Avoid slits above the knee



Slit is too high






Avoid flesh tone fabric underneath dresses with cutouts. The fabric must not convey an image of the skin showing through a sheer fabric.

Approved as long as cutout is no lower than small of back





















ORDERING ONLINE

- Not recommended
- Many are not returnable
- "Rental" options are not available until day before event
- Find a store to try it on with correct sizing
- Sizes are NOT the same as everyday clothing (formal dresses are smaller in size)
