Summer learning loss is a well-documented and frequently researched phenomenon that affects students of all grade levels and aptitudes. The best studies find that students lose on average a month, and up to three months in some cases, of grade-level instruction over the summer break. This same research shows that the amount of loss can increase with grade level. Therefore, the English Department of CCHS encourages students to participate in summer reading. Reading from the list below is designed to help students overcome summer learning loss and to prepare them for the upcoming year of academic growth. Both students and their parents are encouraged to take summer reading seriously and complete the reading assignment as instructed on the following page. This assignment applies to **ALL incoming freshmen** taking English 1 or English 1 Honors.
