# <u> The Power of Desmos: A Digital SAT Game Changer</u>

Desmos Calculator Training for 11th & 12th grade students taking the Digital SAT

With the introduction of the New Digital SAT in the Spring of 2024, one of the most significant changes is the use of a calculator on the entire math section. The Collegeboard has collaborated with Desmos, a powerful online graphing calculator, and embedded this tool for use into the test. This powerful tool can help you get questions correct easily...but you must know how to leverage it. The CCHS Mathematics Dept, College Counseling, and Mrs. Kraus have partnered together to provide free training for 11th and 12th grade students who will be taking the digital SAT this fall. Mrs. Kraus will share her tips & tricks using this tool, including what kinds of problems Desmos can help you get correct as well as save you time! This quick 1 hr session is designed for hands-on practice and for HIGHLY motivated students.

Students in 9th and 10th grade will be receiving introductory training in their math classes this fall in preparation for the October PSAT date.
