The benefit to the subscription is that if any "Away" team we play also streams their games through the NFHS Network, you will be able to watch the "Away" game as well. The subscription is not just to watch CCHS home games.

## Important In-person Spectator Information for Calvary Fall Sports

Due to COVID-19, the following policies, guidelines and protocols are in place for fan attendance at home games at Calvary Christian High School (CCHS). People attending any games affirm they do not have any known symptoms associated with COVID-19, including, but not limited to:

- Fever (100.4 and above) and have not taken medication to reduce a fever within 24 hours of game time
- Shortness of Breath
- Loss of Taste/Smell
- Diarrhea
- Nausea/Vomiting
- Muscle or Body Aches
- Chills
- Cough
- Sore Throat
- Nasal Congestion/Runny Nose
- Fatigue
- Headache

In consideration of being permitted on CCHS' premises and campus, the person in attendance for himself/herself, his/her heirs, legatees and assigns, do hereby knowingly and voluntarily:

- a. release, waive and discharge any claims that I have or may have in connection with COVID-19 and covenant not to file a lawsuit against CCHS, or any of its shareholders directors, officers, employees, and agents (collectively, the "Released Parties") for any injuries, losses, costs, expenses or damages (including any consequential, special or punitive damages) resulting from my contracting COVID-19; and
- b. agree to indemnify and hold harmless each of the Released Parties for all damages, losses, costs and expenses (including, without limitation, reasonable attorneys' fees) incurred or suffered, directly or indirectly, by CCHS in connection with or as a result of my violation of this Acknowledgement, Waiver of Liability and Assumption of Risk Agreement.

***Game attendance will be limited in capacity. CCHS reserves the right to close ticket sales and gate admission without prior notice when the maximum number of attendance capacity is reached.***

## Volleyball Tickets

**Tickets to attend games will be sold at the door**

Tickets to attend games will be sold at the door on a first-come, first-serve basis.

- ⇒ CCHS will utilize a temperature kiosk and related technology to take the temperature of each attendee. Any attendee with a temperature of 100.4 or higher will not be permitted to enter and attend the game.
- ⇒ All attendees must wear a mask to enter the gym and have a temperature screening before entering the gym. CCHS encourages attendees to wear the mask while attending the volleyball game, especially if social distancing may not be maintained.
- ⇒ Attendees **may not** bring outside food or drinks in the gym.
- ⇒ Seating is on a first-come, first-serve basis. All attendees must sit in the bleachers are encouraged to practice social distancing; however, CCHS does not guarantee people will be able to be social distanced from the nearest fan(s). Family groups may sit together.
- ⇒ Attendees may not enter the court before the game, during the game, or after the game.
- ⇒ Attendees may not gather after the game to greet players. Attendees are expected to exit the gym as soon as the game ends. Families may wait for their child (player) in the parking lot.
- ⇒ CCHS reserves the right to dismiss an attendee from the gym if in the school official's determination, the fan is behaving in a manner that puts people in an unhealthy danger or risk.

## CCHS Students attending Home Football Games

- Students attending the game must follow the guidelines listed to the right.
- Students must register to attend the game. Only students on the registered list will be permitted to attend the game.
- Students must enter the designated gate for admission and present their student ID to confirm registration for attendance in order to be given permission to enter stadium.
- Students must sit in the “home” bleachers or stand along the fence on the east side of the stadium.



## Football Tickets

**Tickets to attend games will be sold online.**

It is best to purchase tickets online to attend the games.

A small number of tickets MAY be available to purchase at the ticket window. It is best to purchase tickets online.

- ⇒ All attendees must wear a mask to enter the stadium. CCHS encourages attendees to wear the mask while attending the football game, especially if social distancing may not be maintained.
- ⇒ Attendees **may not** bring outside food or drinks in the stadium.
- ⇒ Seating in the bleachers is on a first-come, first-serve basis. People sitting in the bleachers and are encouraged to practice social distancing; however, CCHS does not guarantee people will be able to sit and be social distanced from the nearest fan(s). Family groups may sit together.
- ⇒ Attendees are also encouraged to spread out and stand along the fence to watch the game.
- ⇒ Attendees may not enter the track or field area before the game, during the game, or after the game.
- ⇒ Attendees may not gather on the *North Fan Plaza* to greet players when they exit the field at half-time or after the game.
- ⇒ Attendees are expected to exit the stadium as soon as the game ends. Families may wait for their child (player) in the parking lot.
- ⇒ CCHS reserves the right to dismiss an attendee from the stadium, if in the school official's determination, the fan is behaving in a manner that puts in people in an unhealthy danger or risk.

### **Visiting Team Attendees, Including Students from the School**

Visiting team attendees, including students from the school, must follow the above guidelines for attending a football game on the campus of Calvary Christian High School.

The visiting team will be allotted the number of tickets based on the limited seating formula to determine attendance capacity. All visiting team attendees, including students from the school, must purchase tickets online. The cost for an admission ticket is \$6 per person (adult, student, or child-regardless of age/grade).

CCHS expects the visiting school's administration to communicate the online link to purchase tickets to their families, students, friends, etc. in a manner they determine who should have the first opportunity to purchase the tickets before distributing the online link to the general school population.

All visiting team attendees, including students from the school, must sit or stand on the west side of the stadium. The west side of the field is designated for visiting team attendees.

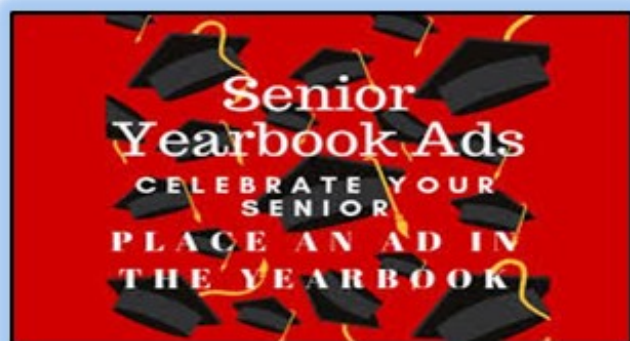
