Final Senior Reminders & Resources

FINAL HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT REQUESTS & NAVIANCE UPDATES:

- All students should enter a final high school transcript request to their <u>ONE</u> college of enrollment to Naviance under the "Colleges I'm Applying To" list.
- All final high school transcripts will be sent to colleges by the second week of June as long as the request is in Naviance
- In rare circumstances you may need a second transcript sent to another college, if so-- you must complete the <u>External Transcript Request Form</u>. (You can also use this form if you're transferring schools in the future.)
- All students should update their Naviance Colleges I'm Applying To list with all their college decisions and to indicate their college of enrollment. <u>See video</u> <u>instructions for help.</u>
- DUAL CREDIT TRANSCRIPTS:
 - CCHS does NOT send these on your behalf, YOU must request the official record be sent from BUF and/or SPC to your college/university of enrollment.
 - It is a requirement that you send official transcripts for any and all college work you've completed to your college of enrollment.
 - BUF Transcript requests use THIS LINK.
 - SPC Transcript requests, use THIS LINK
 - Note: If you're enrolling for a summer semester or attending an orientation event that occurs before the conclusion of your dual enrollment class, it may be wise to request dual credit transcripts for past semesters NOW and then request them a second time at the end of this semester so colleges have as much of your transferable coursework on file as possible before you're selecting classes at the college/university.

AP SCORE SENDING:

- Is optional but if you want to send your official AP scores to colleges for possible college credit, you can do so via your College Board account. Use <u>THIS</u> link for instructions.
- You can send your scores one place for FREE if you submit your request by June
 20. This report will include your past and current year's AP exam results.
- You can search your college/university website for their AP Policy and what scores are needed in order to earn college credit

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- BRIGHT FUTURES:
 - Be sure to <u>login to your account</u> and designate your **college of enrollment and starting semester/academic year** so your funds are appropriately distributed.
 - Read through the <u>Bright Futures Handbook</u> to understand what you need to do each year to maintain your Bright Futures scholarship money.
 - These funds are available for your in-state undergraduate tuition for the next five years as long as you've applied and qualified while in high school.
 - Students who are still trying to qualify may:
 - Retest through August 31, 2025 and must send qualifying scores to any FL PUBLIC college or university
 - Submit the Florida Financial Aid Application to Bright Futures by August 31st by using the link above.
