Letter of Recommendation Survey for Juniors

Some college applications require letters of recommendation from your counselors and teachers. If you are a rising senior who will need a letter of recommendation for your college application or a scholarship you are wishing to apply to, you should complete our <u>Letter of Recommendation Survey</u>, which can be found on your main dashboard of <u>Maia Learning</u>. Please note that your counselors will work on these letters over the summer and teachers will most likely work on letters of recommendation next fall.

Unsure if you need a letter of recommendation?

- ★ <u>None of the FL public universities will accept letters of recommendation</u>
- ★ Check the admissions website of each school you are applying to
- ★ Popular colleges that require rec letters: Duke, Miami, Baylor, Boston College, Boston University, Georgetown, Highpoint, Johns Hopkins, NYU, UNC Chapel Hill, Vanderbilt, Virginia, Wake Forest (there are more, but these are just a few!)



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Registering for the ACT, SAT, or CLT

Rising juniors and seniors (current 10th and 11th grade students) may wish to take advantage of ACT, SAT, and CLT testing available this summer. *CCHS recommends that students begin taking the SAT/ACT/CLT <u>after</u> the student has completed at least one semester of Algebra 2.*
