PSAT Digital Scores Now Available

Juniors and Sophomores- students who have previously created their College Board accounts are able to login and review your recent PSAT scores. These scores are also available to view in Maia Learning ("Academics" Tab → "Test Scores"). An email was sent from our department regarding these scores and how to access them. Please review this email for more details on accessing and understanding your scores.

Freshmen- the college counselors visited your Bible classes last Thursday, November 13th to distribute and explain your PSAT scores. You can also access your score report on the College Board website or you can see your scores in Maia Learning.

Note: If students have any technical issues logging into their account, you will need to call the CollegeBoard directly for technical support. CCHS College Counseling does not have access to private, student accounts- 1 (866) 630-9305.

Junior & Sophomore Individual Counseling Meetings

Start off 2026 with a focus on the future! Juniors & Sophomores are able to schedule an individual college planning meeting with your primary college counselor. Junior meetings are currently open. Sophomore meetings open in January. Create a plan for SAT/ACT/CLT testing, refine your college list, discuss college visits, plan courses for next year, discuss diploma graduation type, review your resume, and much more in these personalized sessions. These can be scheduled in-person, via Google Meet, or a hybrid (student at school; parent on Google Meet). We highly encourage you to schedule prior to March when course selection opens. The counselors calendars fill QUICKLY. Please be sure you schedule during a non-core and non-Bible class period

Registering for ACT and SAT

CCHS recommends that students begin taking the ACT/SAT/CLT after the student has completed Algebra 1, Geometry, and at least one semester of Algebra 2. Most students begin taking the ACT/SAT/CLT at the end of Sophomore year or early into Junior year. It is a CCHS graduation requirement to have at least one ACT, SAT, or CLT test score on file by the first day of senior year. Below are resources



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regarding ACT/SAT/CLT. You can email your primary college counselor with any questions that you may have.

NOTE: When testing digitally, CCHS recommends that students bring a backup device on testing day. This ensures you can access the digital testing platform and avoid disruptions if your primary device fails or cannot connect to Wi-Fi.
