

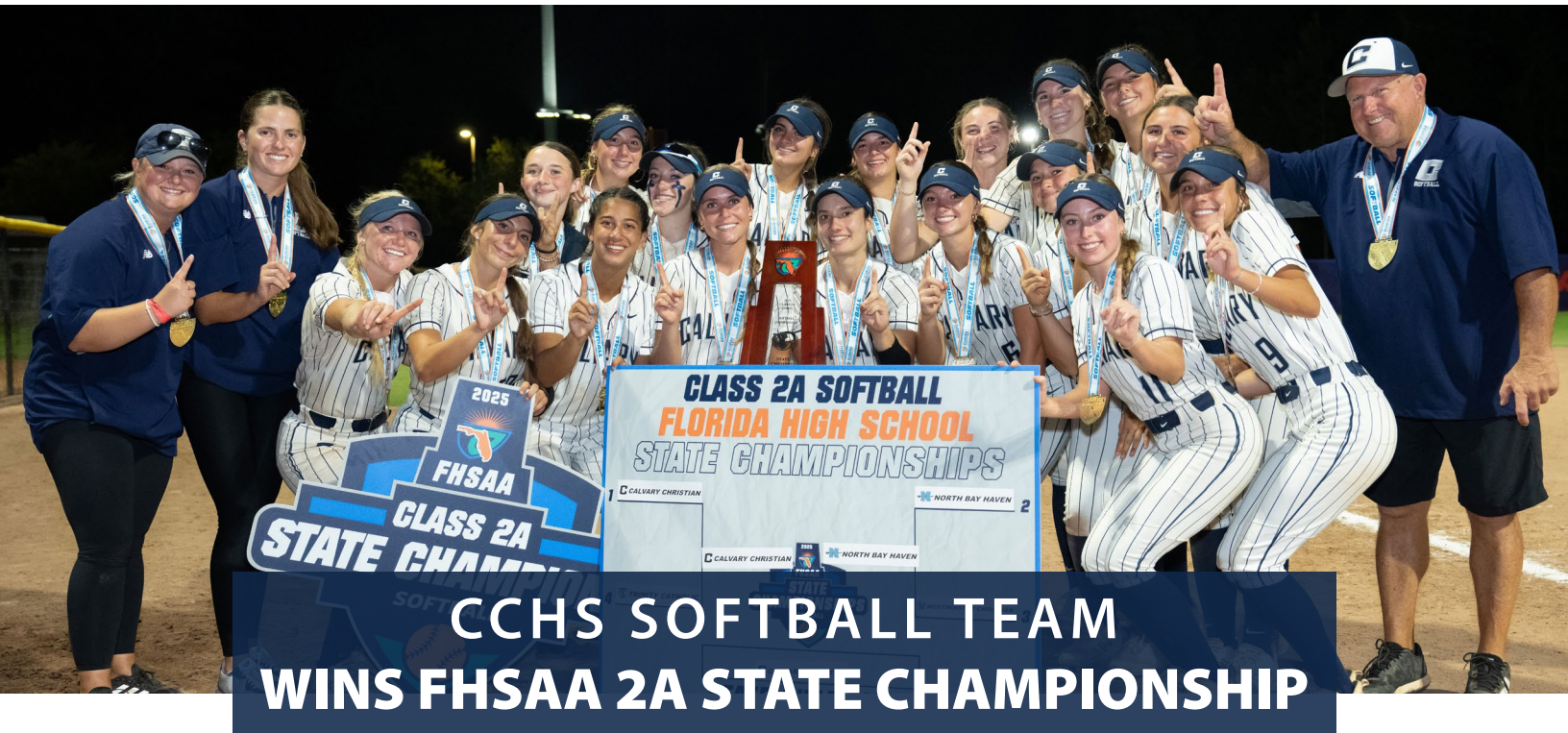

CCHS SOFTBALL TEAM WINS FHSAA 2A STATE CHAMPIONSHIP

Congratulations to the Warrior softball team on winning the FHSAA Class 2A State Championship! The team finished the season with an outstanding 30-1 record. At the end of the regular season, the road to the final four championship started with the district tournament. The Warriors won the 2A District 11 Championship on May 1st with a 10 – 0 victory over Cardinal Mooney from Sarasota. Next, the team participated in the 2A Region 3 Tournament. With mercy rule victories over CCC and Tampa Catholic, the Warriors won the Region 3 Tournament on May 15th with a 6-0 victory over Bishop Verot from Fort Myers to advance to the Final Four State Championship. In the semifinal game on May 20th against Trinity Catholic of Ocala, the Warriors mounted a come from behind victory with a 6-5 win to advance to the championship game. In the championship game on May 21st, the Warriors faced North Bay Haven Academy

from Panama City. The team jumped out to an early lead and held on to win 6-4 to secure the program's third FHSAA state championship in four years. The team's exceptional season earned them a No. 2 ranking in the state and a No. 12 ranking in the nation! The Warriors are led by Head Coach, Amy Smith (CCHS alum in the Class of 2017), who was recognized as the FACA 2A District 14 Coach of the Year. On the field, the players looked to senior, Morgen Talley, to lead the team to a remarkable season with Morgen being chosen as the FACA 2A District 14 Player of the Year. The team demonstrated discipline, determination, and excellence throughout the season and are known throughout the state for their integrity, sportsmanship, and their faith in Christ. CCHS is proud of the coaches and players and look forward to displaying their state championship banner in the new Warrior Softball Complex. #WeAreWarriors

EISENHOWER VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY

CCHS students exemplified servant leadership through a meaningful partnership with Eisenhower Elementary School during the 2024–2025 academic year. A total of 56 students from CCHS volunteered at the elementary school providing 1,711 hours of academic support and mentorship to kindergarten through fifth-grade students.

Each Tuesday and Thursday afternoon, CCHS students dedicated their time to tutoring and mentoring, offering guidance in subjects such as reading, writing, and mathematics. Beyond academics, the goal was to reflect the love of Christ through consistent service and positive relationships.

In addition to weekly mentoring, CCHS students and staff organized and led a Field Day for over 700 Eisenhower students. The Field Day included a dunk tank, water balloon toss, various relay games, and other fun activities for the students to participate in.

CCHS also partnered with Eisenhower in other community-building events, including Eisenhower's Christmas Breakfast, Student Volunteer Night during a CCHS home basketball game, and Eisenhower Family Night during a CCHS home football game.

CCHS is proud of the student volunteers and looks forward to continuing the relationship with Eisenhower Elementary School in the years ahead.





SPRING MUSICAL AWARDS

The 2025 CCHS Musical, *Anastasia*, was evaluated by professional judges from the Straz Center for the Performing Arts as part of the Broadway Stars of the Future program. The musical was evaluated in many categories including acting, singing, set design, and orchestra. Each evaluated category receives a numerical score from the judges and the categories that score particularly high are eligible to earn a nomination for various awards. CCHS's presentation of *Anastasia* nearly earned a perfect overall score and additionally received five award nominations.
