CCHS CELEBRATES OUTSTANDING AP EXAM SUCCESS

CCHS has a distinguished history of outstanding performance in Advanced Placement (AP) examinations. Between 349 students, 571 AP Exams were taken in 19 CCHS AP courses. **This year, every CCHS AP Course earned an average passing score above 80%.** This surpassed both Florida and national averages significantly.

The following **nine AP Exams earned a perfect 100% pass rate:** 2D Art, 3D Art, Calculus BC, Precalculus, Macroeconomics, U.S. Government & Politics, U.S. History, Computer Science Principles, and Spanish Language.

The following **three AP Exams earned pass rate above 90%:** English Literature, Chemistry, and English Language.

The following **seven AP Exams earned a pass rate between 80–90%:** Human Geography, World History, Environmental Science, Biology, Calculus AB, Psychology, and Statistics.


