CCHS Choral Director, Mr. Brandon Martell, will have his seventh choral piece, and fourth original composition, published in the Spring of 2026 catalogue of Galaxy Music Corporation. His piece, "With Songs Gushing From Your Heart," is an adapted setting of a Henry Wadsworth Longfellow poem. When submitting a choral piece to be published, the industry standard is to have a demonstration recording for the choral editor of the company to listen to along with the sheet music. Getting this piece published is particularly special for Mr. Martell because the demonstration recording was performed by Calvary Choir, at their FVA State Choral MPA performance in April of 2025.
