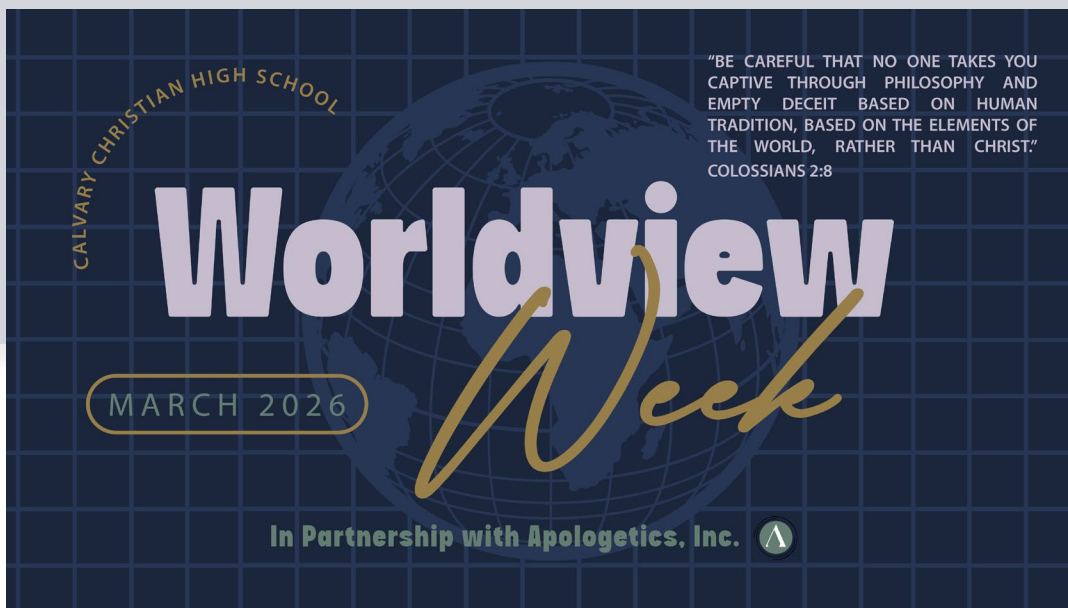

STANDARDIZED TESTING AT CCHS THURSDAY, MARCH 26TH

CCHS will be administering standardized testing on **March 26th**. View instructions for each grade level below:

Grades 9 and 10:

- Students will take the Pre-ACT test to receive an estimated ACT score. Scores are also used in course placement advising for the next school year.
- Report to the assigned testing room at the beginning of the school day on Thursday, March 26th.
- CCHS will provide breakfast items for students in Cafe One:22 and the Williamson Room.
- Bring pencils, a calculator, water, a snack, and a book for reading (*optional*).
- Testing will conclude around 11:15 AM.
- No after-school supervision is available. Students must leave campus by 11:45 AM unless they have a team or group practice.

Grade 11:

- Students will take the SAT during the school day.
- Report to the assigned testing room at the beginning of the school day on Thursday, March 26th.
- CCHS will provide breakfast items for students in Cafe One:22 and the Williamson Room.
- Students will need a fully charged iPad, a pencil, a calculator, water, a snack, and a book (*optional*).
- Testing should conclude around 11:15 AM.
- No after-school supervision is available. Students must leave campus by 11:45 AM unless they have a team or group practice.

Grade 12:

- No school on Thursday, March 26th.
- Students are expected to attend team or group practices in the afternoon.

CCHS is exploring the launch of a CCHS Warriors Hockey Team as a club sport competing in the Lightning High School Hockey League. The team is a club sport, and the league is not affiliated with the Florida High School Athletic Association (FHSAA). The estimated cost to participate is approximately \$1,300 per student, which includes equipment, uniforms, and registration, payable to the **Lightning High School Hockey League**.

Dr. Tyler Nickel, CCHS Class of 2017 and current Biology and Anatomy & Physiology teacher, will serve as the team's Head Coach.

The goal is to form a team of at least 20 CCHS students. Registration will begin in May, and the league will begin practice and games in August.
