2026 SPRING BREAK MISSION TRIPS

During Spring Break 2026, CCHS students traveled around the country and world to share the Gospel and love of Jesus Christ.

Team Guatemala:

Mr. Cave, Mrs. Stenberg, Ms. Wells, and Mr. Eide took a group of 24 10th-12th grade CCHS students to Coban, Guatemala. The team partners with the K'ekchi Baptist Convention, led by Pastor German Contreras and his sons, Wilson and Henry Contreras. Each day, the team went to a K'ekchi Baptist church in a local village. They visited homes of unchurched individuals and gave the Gospel message. Each afternoon, the team led a VBS service for the children of the village.

Team London:

Dr. Randall, Mrs. Kraus, Coach Safford, and Mrs. Jannarone led a group of 24 CCHS students to London. Throughout the week, they engaged with the local community and ministered in the streets of London. Students prayed for many individuals, knocked on 2500 doors offering prayer and hope, engaged local university students from different religious backgrounds in conversations about the Gospel, distributed over 400 bibles, gathered over 30 contacts to share with local church partners, led worship, served the homeless, and fell more in love with a city that is in need of the Good News of Jesus Christ. The team learned ministry skills in London that they brought home to Florida to share the Gospel with those around them.

Team New York:

Mr. Cautero, Mr. Mohler, Ms. Rozeveld, and Ms. Evans led 22 CCHS students to New York where they partnered with NYSUM (New York School of Urban Ministries) for five days of ministry outreach in the five boroughs of New York City. Students engaged in hands-on compassion ministry and inner-city evangelism. They worked alongside NYSUM and its multiple partners as servant leaders to reach people for Jesus through street evangelism, prayer encounters, soup kitchens, food pantries, meals on wheels, children's ministry programs and city shelters. The team is thankful for the many ways the Lord moved in their lives and the lives of others.

CCHS is thankful for the Lord's protection during their travels and is proud of these teams who continue to share the Good News of Jesus Christ.
