All exam days will be **half days**, with dismissal at **12:15 PM**.

**EXAM EXEMPTION
REQUEST DAY:
MAY 11TH**

What to Know:

- Exams are given in core subjects only (English, Math, Science, History, World Language).
- AP students are exempt from semester exams; their national AP exam fulfills the requirement.
- Students without exams may stay home or must report to our supervised study hall if on campus.
- Students must be in dress code, arrive on time, and stay for the full exam period.
- After school supervision is not provided on exam days. All students must exit campus by 12:30 PM.

Exam Exemption Criteria:

- **9th–11th Grade:** May exempt up to 2 exams with an A average and 5 or fewer absences (Jan 12–May 11).
- **12th Grade:** May exempt up to 4 exams with an A or B average and 5 or fewer absences (Jan 12 - May 11).
- Dual Credit classes are not eligible. Students with ISS/OSS in semester 2 must take all exams. Students with an unexcused absence on the ACSI Student Apologetics Day must take all exams.

Exemption Request Process (May 11):

- Students will receive the form via email at 7:45 AM and must submit it by 4:30 PM.
- Only students may complete the form using their CCHS email.
- Review eligibility via FACTS Report Card starting May 11.
- Final exemption status will be approved and available in the report card by end of day May 13.

CALVARY CHOIR EARNED A “STRAIGHT SUPERIOR” RATING



On Wednesday, April 22nd, Calvary Choir earned a “Straight Superior” rating at the Florida Vocal Association’s (FVA) State Choral Music Performance Assessment. Additionally, the adjudicators scored the choir with all “A” ratings across each caption. Similar to high school athletics, FVA holds a District performance event. If a choir scores high enough at Districts, they qualify for States. After the Calvary Choir earned a “Straight Superior” rating at Districts, performing two pieces, they began preparing “Witness” by Jack Halloran to add to their repertoire

for State. The lyrics of “Witness” depict the biblical accounts of Nicodemus and Samson and Deliah, to demonstrate that God can use anyone to be a witness for Him, and for His glory and purposes. NATIONAL SPANISH EXAMINATION AWARDS

Congratulations to several CCHS Spanish Honors students who attained national recognition for excellent performance on the 2026 National Spanish Examinations. Students from CCHS earned a total of 5 gold, 1 silver and 7 bronze medals along with 54 honorable mentions. "Attaining a medal or honorable mention for any student on the National Spanish Examinations is very prestigious," said Lisa Greenman, National Director of the Exams, "because the exams are the largest of their kind in the United States with nearly 85,000 students participating in 2026." CCHS Spanish Honors students have a history of high achievement on these exams and were taught by Spanish teachers Mrs. Lisa Clarke, Mr. Michael Flecker, Mrs. Amy Schabillon, and Mrs. Yadira Morales Rivera. The National Spanish Examinations are administered each year in grades 6 through 12, and are sponsored by the American Association of Teachers of Spanish and Portuguese.
